## **Templates for GovRAMP Statuses**

## Overview

Achieving a GovRAMP status—Ready, Provisionally Authorized, or Authorized—requires an independent audit conducted by Third Party Assessing Organizations (3PAOs). After the 3PAO audit for Ready or Authorized status, the provider and 3PAO must submit a final package to the GovRAMP PMO for security review.

## Key Components of the Final Packages:

- Assessors must provide a package that includes:
  - Assessor Matrix: Incorporates the GovRAMP Readiness Assessment Review (RAR), GovRAMP Security Assessment Review (SAR), test case procedures, risk exposure template, and system overview.
  - Security Assessment Plan
- Service Providers must provide a security package that includes:
  - Operational Controls Matrix: Formerly known as the System Security Plan (SSP).
  - Continuous Monitoring Matrix: Now combined with a Plan of Action & Milestones (POA&M).

Products achieving any of the three statuses will be listed on the <u>GovRAMP Authorized Product List</u> (<u>APL</u>).
